Still, for breakfasts and lunches this good, we'll wait. Morning's glory might be a quick scone and coffee, or linger-worthy cheddar biscuits and gravy. For lunch, Taste serves soups, salads and sandwiches both complex (tuna nicoise) and simple (roast beef). Everything's available to go, or you can sit at small tables inside or out. Whatever else you choose, do not miss the pommes frites, wrapped in wax paper and popped into a tin, with a side of aioli so good you'll be tempted to dip the wax paper in it when the salty, peppery fries are all gone. And finish your meal with the swooningly decadent chocolate pot de cremes, a cross between the world's richest mousse and creamiest fudge. See you in line.
